Option 1) take ECE 115 for 4 credit hours before or concurrently with courses requiring ECE 115 ECE 225, 265, 310, 346. For these courses, ECE 115 pre-requisite becomes a co-requisite. Students must complete a Transfer Student ECE 115 Petition and drop it off with proper documentation in SEO 1020 for approval.	
Option 2) be waived ECE 115 and granted access to higher level ECE courses requiring ECE 115 — ECE 225, 265, 310, 346. For these courses, the 115 pre-requisite is waived, and the student must make up for the 4 credit hours from ECE 115 in ECE courses at or above the 200 level that are not being used to fulfill other graduation requirements. Students must complete a Transfer Student ECE 115 Petition and drop it off with proper documentation in SEO 1020 for approval.
